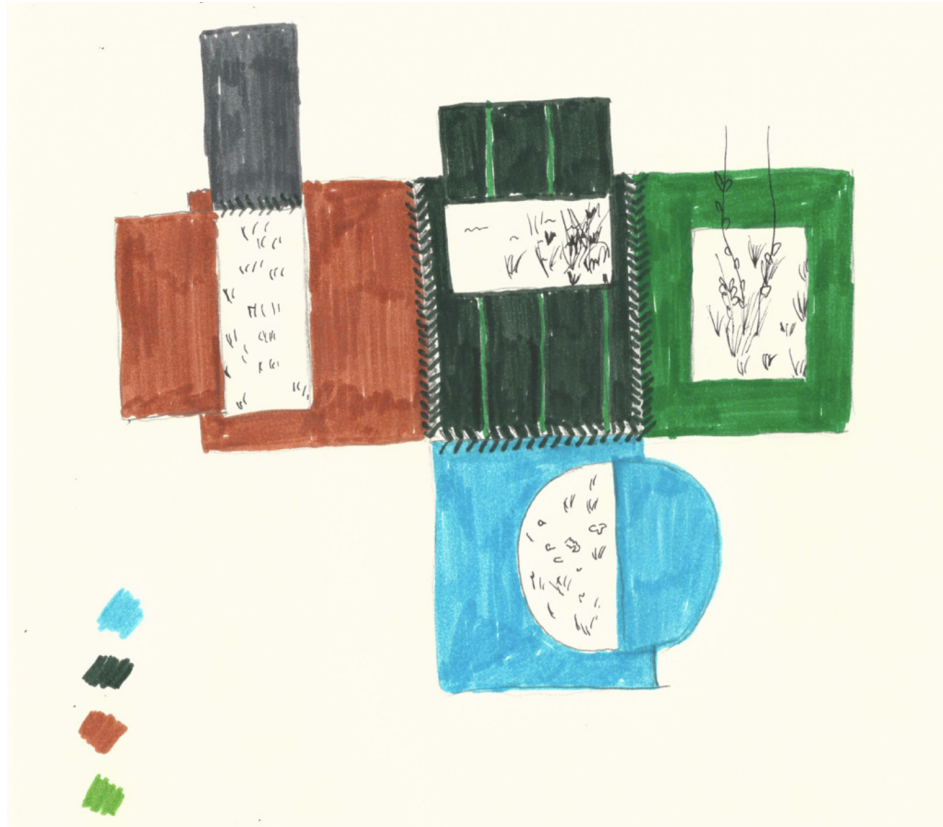


Outil d'observation des sols vivants

**Soil Blanket**

*living soil observation tool*

The blanket is developed as a tool to come together while getting close to the soil. As an object that can be unfold on past and future research locations it makes an action-ground relation. In different configurations the blanket negotiates between providing human and more than human comfort, while remaining flexible to adapt to the constraints of the place. The 3 pieces can be attached to each other or used independently. They are each consisting different layers of textile that can be unfold, to give specific comfort for the soil investigation, some are equipped with pockets and openings to store instruments or objects. Layered on top of each other they remember a cushion that pads out more coarse or cold undergrounds. Fully unfold the object let soil remain- framed by a thin frame to sit on and...change perspective?

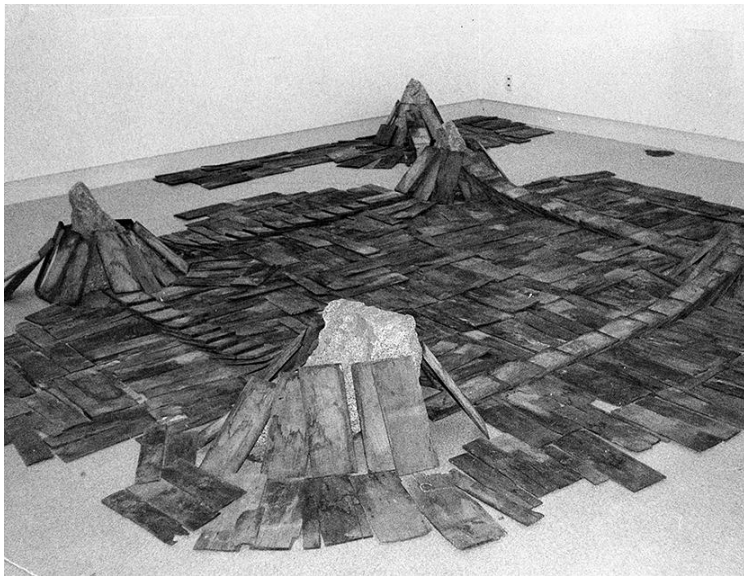

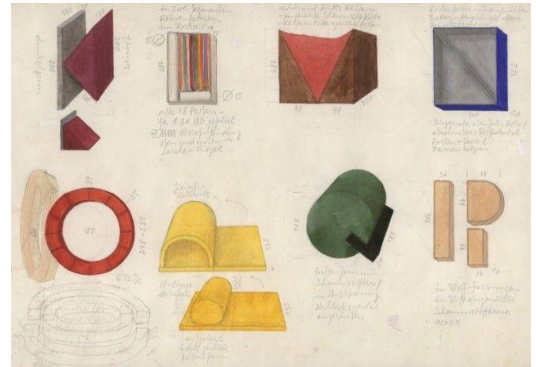
